The Lutheran Vanguard Front Ensemble is a highly specialized percussion ensemble comprised of mallet instruments (marimba, vibraphone, xylophone, bells, etc.) and other auxiliary percussion instruments.

Positions in the Front Ensemble are open to any WELS student percussionist, piano player, or musician who can read music and is regularly enrolled in their high school band program, choir program, or regularly taking lessons.
